KEEPING IN TOUCH WITH THE TRIP

We're willing to bet that, as a parent, you'd appreciate some updates and photos of your students from time to time throughout the week. Rather than inundate social media with photos throughout the trip, trip leaders will have the ability to post photos and comments throughout the day using a group chat we have established in WhatsApp. To gain access to these updates, please note the following instructions.

1) Download the WhatsApp Messenger app from your app store

2) Set up your WhatsApp account using the prompts within the app

HOW TO PRAY FOR YOUR STUDENTS

We ask that you spend some time each day this week praying for your student. Our hope is that students would hear from the Holy Spirit this week that and those who do not yet know Jesus would choose to follow him. For those students who already are Christ followers, we pray that God would speak to them in a fresh way and they would follow him in obedience.

Day 1: Understanding

Pray that our students would understand that in the beginning, God created a perfect world. That His desire is for us to live with him.

Day 2: Conviction

Pray that students would be broken over their own sin. Pray that we would recognize the division that sin creates between us and God and that the story of the gospel is the only remedy to this division.

Day 3: Repentance

Pray that each of our students would be able to admit that we are broken. Pray that we would accept Jesus' invitation to turn away from our sin and live in community with him.

Day 4: Restoration

Pray that we would not be tempted to end the story at the sinner's prayer. Pray that we would each commit to living in relationship with Christ. Pray that the Holy Spirit would empower us to pursue his design and assure us of his presence.

PACKING LIST

BRING THESE

- Twin sheets and/or sleeping bag and pillow
- Bath towel
- Appropriate Swimwear (See note below)
- Refillable water bottle
- Closed toe, closed heel shoes
- Bible, notepad, and pen
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, etc.)
- Sun/bug protection
- An Alarm clock (students will not have their phones overnight)
- Spending money for coffee shop, snack bar, camp store, and missions offering (optional)
- Summer Clothing
- Clothes for Mega Relay - Theme: Galaxy (l.e. NASA, Cosmic, Aliens, etc.)
- Missions Offering

DON'T BRING THESE

- Alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs
- Fireworks
- Any kind of weapon
- Anything that resembles a weapon
- Pornography of any kind
- Anything that could be used for pranks (water balloons, silly string, etc)
- Energy drinks
- A negative attitude

NOTES:

The above list is intended to be but may not be exhaustive. Students and parents should use common sense when deciding whether or not an item is appropriate to pack. In order to ensure the safety and spirit of this trip, students found to be in possession of any of the above items will have the item confiscated, their parent will be notified, and the student's immediate dismissal will be required.

*Note about swimwear - to my knowledge there is no pool made available to the students; however, there is lake kayaking and water games. Nothing to my knowledge *requires* a bathing suit but should your student decide to pack one please make sure that all swimwear (for both guys and girls) is tasteful. FUGE stipulates that ladies wear tasteful one-pieces or a two-piece bathing suit covered with a dark t-shirt.

Parents are responsible for arranging transportation for students dismissed from trips.

CELL PHONE POLICY – GLADE STUDENTS

Spirit of this policy

Access to cell phones and social media can enhance some portions of the camp experience. Access also gives parents the opportunity to contact their student directly. However, cell phones have also proven themselves to be an endemic distraction and there is no essential element of camp that can not be experienced without a phone. It is our intent to allow students and parents the highest degree of autonomy possible while preserving the safety, integrity and experience of all students in attendance.

Should I send my student with a phone?

As a parent, you are the first line of defense and sound decision making for your student. As stated above, there is no essential element of camp that cannot be experienced without a phone. Please only send a phone with your student if you can confidently agree to each of the statements below.

- My student consistently shows sound judgement in the use of his/her phone.
- My student does not use his/her phone at inappropriate times or in inappropriate ways.
- I have had a conversation with my student about responsible phone use on church trips.

Students who bring a phone to camp

In order to preserve the safety, integrity, and experience of all students, students whose parents send them with a phone will be required to adhere to the following guidelines:

- The student will notify the trip leader at check-in that they are bringing a phone to camp.
- The student will turn their phone in to the respective chaperones by 11pm each evening.
- The student will arrive at breakfast before 8:00am each morning to retrieve their phone.
- Chaperones will not be responsible for charging student phones. It is recommended that students monitor their battery life and leave phones to charge in their rooms during Worship, Recreation, or Hang Time.
- Leaders, Chaperones, or The Glade Church are not responsible for damage or loss of any student's phone.

Students who misuse their phones

Trip leaders reserve the right to confiscate a student's cell phone. Parents of students who have their cell phone confiscated will be notified immediately. A student will have their phone confiscated and returned only when the group arrives back at The Glade church if the student is found to have used the phone in any of the following ways:

- Accessing any inappropriate content
- Harassing another student or leader through the use of technology
- Using the phone at inappropriate times or in inappropriate ways (FUGE camp policy prohibits the use of cell phones during morning celebration, night life, worship, recreation, or track times.)
- Failure to turn phone in to a chaperone by 11pm each evening

CODE OF CONDUCT – GLADE STUDENTS

Illegal Possession

The possession of any items listed below is considered by the church to be grounds for immediate action. Should any Next Generation leader witness or have knowledge of a student at a church sponsored activity who is in possession of any of these items, the leader(s) will notify the trip leader and, if warranted, the appropriate authorities.

- Alcohol, illegal drugs, pornography, or tobacco products
- Firearms, knives, martial arts items, or any other weapons.

Inappropriate Behaviors

The following lists behaviors and activities which are prohibited by students at any church sponsored event.

- Assault
- Physical displays of affection (beyond handholding and light hugs)
- Leaving an event/activity without consent from a ministry leader
- Leaving church property without consent from a parent or ministry leader
- Vandalism or willful damage to property
- Breaking curfew on an overnight church activity
- Stealing
- Body piercing or permanent tattooing while on a church sponsored outing
- Wearing inappropriate or revealing clothing

Actions

The following outlines how we will manage infractions of the guidelines listed above.

- Trip leader and a group of chaperones will discuss the infraction
- Student will have an opportunity to explain the situation
- Trip leader and chaperones will make a decision based on the severity of the infraction to:
 - Call parents of student
 - Remove student from event / trip / outing
 - Suspension from future ministry events
 - Notification of proper authorities
