55+ will be returning in 2019 to Lynch, KY to assist Meridzo Ministries in their efforts to reach the lost for Christ through the revitalization of the town. This involves providing employment and training, which become the tools for sharing the Gospel.

Our efforts this year will focus less on construction and maintenance and more on ministry and interaction with the local residents. The dates are May 19-22 and the cost will be \$125.00 per person. Registration begins on March 31 by completing the registration cards at the Connect Desk along with payment of \$42 to guarantee your reservation. A second payment of \$42 will be due on April 17 with the balance of \$41 due on May 5, 2019.

2019 will be a year of transition for our Fall Retreat. Family Assistance Ministry

The Glade Church has long had a history of care and concern for the less fortunate of our community. We have provided, food, automobiles, and monetary assistance with rent and utilities. We also provide housing, laundry, and meal preparation for the homeless men of our county through "Compassionate Hands".

To maintain this ministry, 55+ is sponsoring an expansion of these efforts by seeking to offer stated and longer periods of availability when these services can be provided. This will be a church-wide effort involving the enlistment of individuals who would be willing to give 2 hours per month to staff a "Family Assistance Center" where these services can be offered and available. The more volunteers we have, the more hours the family assistance can be open and available.

Training will be provided as this effort will also make it possible to be more intentional and deliberate in our efforts to assist with spiritual needs as well as the physical.
